25¢ CUP CHARGE IN EFFECT

Effective July 1, 2022, any person, business, event, food truck or other entity, including both permanent and temporary facilities, which sells or provides hot or cold beverages in a single-use disposable cup must charge an additional twenty-five cents (25¢) for each cup. 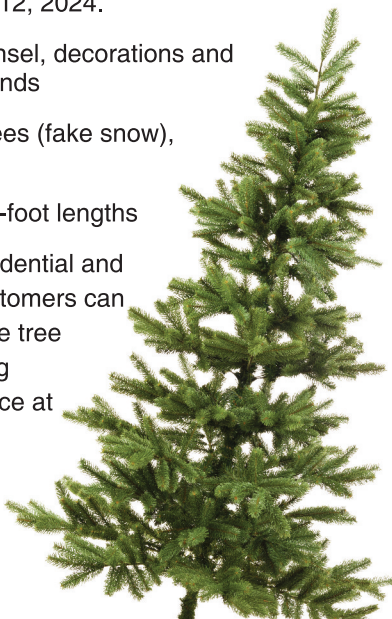
HOLIDAY TREE RECYCLING

Single-family residential customers of GreenWaste Recovery can recycle your evergreen tree curbside on your regular service day, January 1-12, 2024.

- Remove all tinsel, decorations and non-wood stands
- No flocked trees (fake snow), please!
- Cut trees to 6-foot lengths
